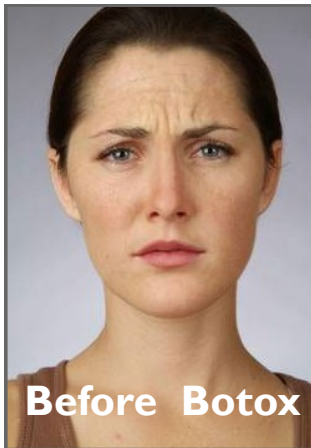

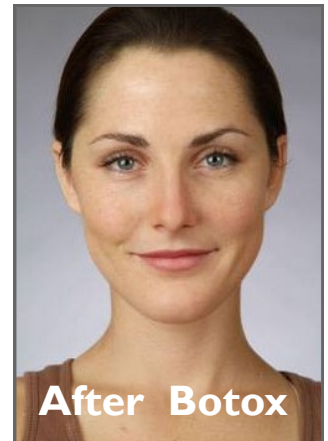


Botox is a simple procedure for effectively smoothing persistent forehead frown lines and crow's feet (laughter lines) in men and women to give a more relaxed and youthful appearance. A very fine needle is used to inject Botox, a natural purified protein into facial muscles, causing them to relax. The injections are very safe and usually painless. The injections temporarily block nerve impulses that trigger wrinkle-causing contractions. Results can last for up to 4 months. Treatment takes 15 to 20 minutes. The initial effect is seen within 5 days and the maximum effect 14 days after treatment. Cost from £250 .

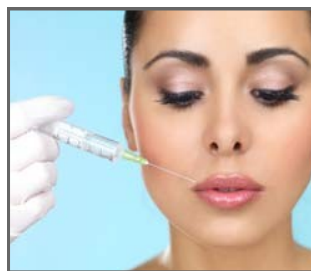

The gels are used in different thicknesses depending on the result desired. It can be used on lines around eyes, cheeks and forehead and on skin indentations.

Small injections, are given to the required areas. An instant result can be seen, with effects lasting between 6 and 12 months.
